ISSUES

1. Illegal appointment of Assistant Professors in Education Course to the sanctioned posts of teachers for B.Ed Course.
2. Issue of appointment of the Head of the Department of Library and Information Science.
3. Repeated delays in providing appointment letters to the part-time teachers of the evening courses, as well as non-payment of remuneration to such teachers.
4. Non-payment of examination remuneration to the teachers' during the last five years.
5. Irregularities in the conduct of examinations and publication of results.
6. Steps taken for removing the difficulties faced by teachers' due to various anomalies in the implementation of the RUSA 2.0 project.
7. Procedural lapses involved in the official hand over and takeover of JUMS, as well as utilization of fund allocated for the project. Status of the EC sub-committee's investigation into alleged irregularities in the procurement of items, utilization of funds received from central and state government projects, and University funds.

8. Extension of the age of superannuation for the full time Contractual Teachers from 60 to 65 years.
9. Long pending appointment of Associate Professor in the School of School of Materials Science & Nanotechnology, and Status of promotion of Dr. Debashis Mridha, Dept. of Education, through CAS.
10. Academic and related administrative status of full-time Contractual Teachers, including their scope of involvement in BoS meetings, PhD supervision, and leave rules that apply to them. Deferrals of pay fixation and annual increments for such teachers on a recurring basis.
11. Status of the case of Prof. Kanak Sarkar of the Department of International Relations with regard to his suspension and disciplinary proceedings against him.
12. Concrete steps taken by the University, in compliance with the EC Resolution (2014), UGC directives, and State Government Circular, for making the University Campus free from liquor, drug and narcotics abuse.
13. Purchase of laptops for providing teaching aid to the teachers, especially for conducting online classes directed by the University due to the situation caused by Covid-19 pandemic.
14. A request to the University for organizing a convention on National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 involving the stakeholders.
15. Procedure adopted for accommodating students in the University hostels.
16. Review of University purchase rules in light of relevant state and central government rules applicable for the purpose.
